NOTES FOR EXHIBITORS:



- a) Make a list of the cats you have entered.
- b) When completing your entry forms, remember to put the registration details of your cat from the certificate of registration or transfer. Also remember to put all your cats claimed titles and those of the sire and dam.
- c) Bring Vaccination Cards for ALL KITTENS entered!
- d) Email the entry clerk after closing date to get confirmation that your entries were received and accepted.
- e) Arrive at the show in plenty of time to prepare your benching cages and in time for in-cage vetting.
- f) Remember to bring advertising material for the top of your benching cages.
- g) Remember to bring litter boxes and water and food containers for your exhibits.
- h) Remember to be courteous to genuine enquiries from the public and a good sport with fellow competitors.
- i) Be ready and willing to contribute to the fun atmosphere at any CATZ Inc. show!
